The meeting was called to order with the Pledge of Allegiance led by Mayor Marksberry with all of Council present.

New Business

Paving quotes for Schroeder/New Fairgrounds Parking Lot

Mike Northcutt presented three quotes to Council and Mayor Marksberry for the paving of the parking lot at the Schroeder Park Community Building as follows:

Dave O'Mara 25,980
Paul Rohe 26,836
Sedam Contracting 28,205.38

There was discussion the paving of this parking lot was recommended by the Park Task Force for this project. After further discussion a motion was made by Councilman Padgett to approve the quote from Dave O'Mara in the amount of \$25,980 upon recommendation of the Park Task Force, 2nd by Councilman Graves; motion carried 5-0. Clerk Gipson also requested permission to cut a check to the Jean Jackson Estate for \$15,000 once the property purchase documentation is received. After discussion a motion was made by Councilman Radcliff to approve the payment of \$15,000 to the Jean Jackson Estate for purchase of approximately 3 acres once proper documentation is received; 2nd by Councilman Graves; motion carried 5-0. These costs will be paid from the New Fairgrounds Park funded by the City and County to build and renovate this park.

Northcutt requested a Council appointment to the Appearance Review Committee that will meet on September 27th at 6:00 pm regarding the approval of paint colors for the former Dibble Hardware Building. After discussion it was decided by Council that Councilman Radcliff will attend as Council representative.

Street Closings for Art Festival—Sept 18-19

Street closings were requested for the Art Festival as follows: Main Street from Alley at Heritage Hall to the Pavilion—Friday evening, Saturday, and Sunday until 5pm. Northcutt stated the winery will be located at the pavilion and will be open until 7pm. Poplar Street will remain open. After discussion a motion was made by Councilman Powell to approve the street closings for the Art Festival, 2nd by Councilman Graves; motion carried 5-0.

Street Closings for Navy Bean Festival—Oct 8 & 9

Street closings were requested for the Navy Bean Festival. See attached Exhibit A. After discussion a motion was made by Councilman Padgett to approve the street closings for the Navy Bean Festival, 2nd by Councilman Radcliff; motion carried 5-0.

Ordinance 2010-2 Salary Ordinance—2nd Reading

Clerk Gipson presented Ordinance 2010-2 "Salary Ordinance" to Council for second reading. After discussion Councilman Radcliff made a motion to give a 2% increase to City Employees excluding Senior Street Labor, Seasonal Workers, Park, Redevelopment, Plan Commission, BZA and RLF Directors, Board Secretaries, extra clerical. Street Dept Step up pay and RLF Executive Director Pay is deleted and the Senior Street Laborer will receive 75 cents more than the Street Laborer position. This was 2nd by Councilman Powell; motion carried 5-0.

Kay Fleming gave Council and Mayor Marksberry a brief update regarding the Grand Victoria sale.

With no further business before Council; a motion to adjourn was made by Councilman Padgett, 2nd by Councilman Slack; meeting adjourned at 5:55pm.

Walnut Street, turn right on South Walnut Street, turn left on Second Street, turn right on South Poplar Street, turn right on First Street, cross South Walnut Street and proceed to South Mulberry Street. All walkers and motorized participants will return to the Rising Sun High School along First Street. Horses will continue along Mulberry, crossing Main Street and turn left on Fourth, returning to the Fairgrounds. Horses will line-up at the Fairground and will leave the Fairground from Nelson Road to Fourth Street to proceed to the Parade Route.
