

IN THE MATTER OF THE PROPOSED ANNEXATION  
IN THE CITY OF RISING SUN

RESOLUTION NO. 2003-4

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Rising Sun, Indiana is considering the annexation of the property in the City of Rising Sun; and

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Rising Sun, Indiana held a meeting on the 6th day of March, 2003, for the purpose of considering such annexation; and

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Rising Sun, Indiana deems it advisable to comply with the annexation requirements set forth in LC. 36-4-3;

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Common Council of Rising Sun, Indiana, that in compliance with I.C. 36-4-3 as follows to-wit:

1. The cost estimates of all capital services required in the area to be annexed are currently estimated at 0 because city services are already available to the area.
2. The planned services of a capital nature, if any, will be borne by the owner, and services of a non-capital nature will be provided by the city of Rising Sun and will be included in its city budget for the furnishing of police and other city services.
3. That planned services of a non-capital nature, including police protection, fire protection, and road maintenance, and other non-capital services normally provided within the corporate boundaries will be provided to the annexed territory within one (1) year after the effective date of annexation, and that they will be provided in a manner equivalent in standard and scope to those non-capital services provided to areas within the corporate boundaries that have similar topography, patterns of land use, and population density.
4. Territory within three (3) years after the effective date of the annexation in the same manner as those services provided to areas within the corporate boundaries that have similar topography, patterns of land use, and population density, and in a manner consistent with federal, state, and local laws, procedures, and planning criteria.
5. There is no need for a plan for hiring the employees of other governmental entities whose jobs will be eliminated by the proposed annexation for there is no plan to eliminate any government employee positions.
