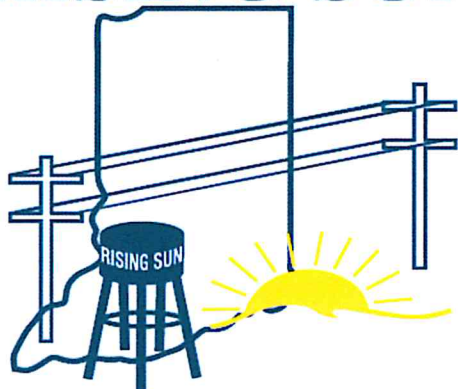

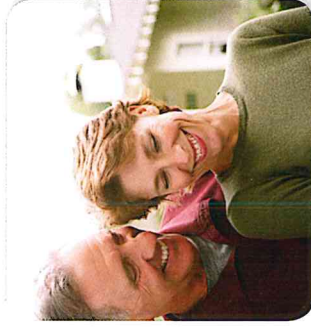

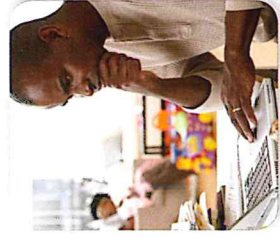

- Replace traditional incandescent light bulbs with energy-efficient CFLs
- Insulate hot water pipes
- Wrap/insulate water heater tanks (electric heaters only)
- Install low-flow faucet aerators and shower heads
- Seal air leaks in ductwork, walls and windows identified by diagnostic equipment
- Improve insulation levels as indicated by testing (only in electrically heated homes)
